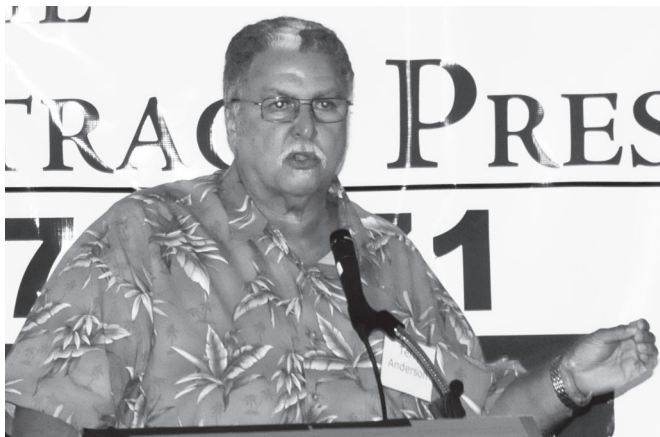


2009 Writers' Workshop Draws Record Attendance
